

The Hawkins County Schools Family Resource Center strives to meet our local students' physical and social needs. Located behind Rogersville Middle School, the Center works with various community agencies to provide items such as clothing, shoes, school supplies, winter coats, and food to needy children in our area.

Any family with a child attending a school in the Hawkins County School System is eligible to access the Food Pantry one time each month.
